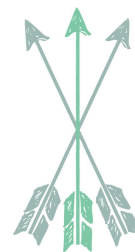


LITTLEST ARROWS

Course Description

Students will explore and discover the world around them, through engaging hands on activities that will stimulate their cognitive, physical, social emotional, and language development. Activities will be presented to engage the mind, body, and senses, encouraging the development of the whole self. Students will utilize a work period based on personal interest, ability, and careful observation of developmental growth.

Focus Objectives

» Cognitive Development

Children will be presented with new materials each week to allow for problem solving, organizing, classifying, reasoning and thinking. We will explore many themes and interest within the cultural arts over the year.

» Language Development

Children will explore songs, stories, rhymes, and poems that facilitates oral language through retelling, asking and answering questions, and repetition. Children will be introduced to early language skills, like phonics and rhymes, through games and traditional Montessori materials.

» Social-Emotional Development

Children will complete practical life and grace and courtesy lessons together as a group and individually. These lessons will enable the child to become a confident member of their world with a sense of value with in it.

» Physical Development

Children will participate in fun balance, coordination, and concentration activities that encourage the growth of small and large motor skills, as well as attention span.

» Mathematics

Children will explore materials to organize and master basic concepts for mathematical understanding. Introduction of numerals, quantity, decimal system, geometric solids, and more will be presented through many traditional Montessori materials.

*Materials Fee : \$40.00 (non refundable)

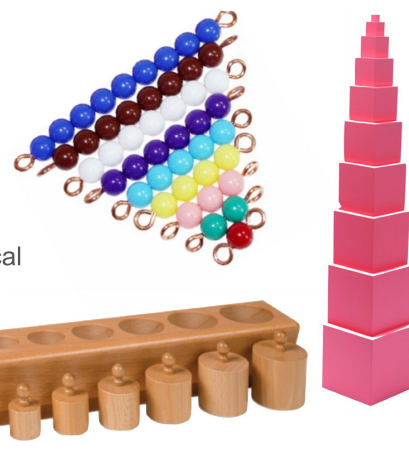
Payments:
