In the process, you will likely find yourself becoming more responsible, less dependent on your parents, and a more active member of your family, church, and community.

This class will cover basic life topics such as budgeting & saving, planning for life after high school, clothing care (& sewing), meal planning & prep, auto and home maintenance, basic first aid, insurance, and civic responsibilities.

Tuition Policy:


Tuition for this class is \$350.
