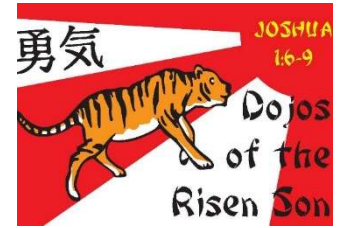

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Ages 8 – adult (5-7 year olds WITH PARENT AS A REGISTERED STUDENT). Please call with questions)

All students begin at white belt level. Progress depends on individual maturity, ability, age and perseverance. **All parents are encouraged to register.** Registration includes the opportunity to attend any of our other classes held weekly at our other dojo locations. (Please see website for days, times and locations). Our program was modified in March of 2020 from Taekwondo to Karate in order to provide a martial arts program for students to achieve any level of proficiency they desire. The system being taught is Tatsu Te Ryu Karate-Do and is based in Shotokan Karate. Most assignments are completed during class. Homework includes practice of katas (highly recommended) and scripture memorization, among other suggestions. **Parents are encouraged to take the class with their children.** Belt tests are given as the student progresses at their own pace and as they have pretested & shown readiness. Students who pass will receive an accredited belt rank. If requested, a Physical Education grade will be given at the completion of this course.

Required Materials:

- Uniform (Gi) purchased from the instructor for \$55.00.
- The uniform fee includes Gi, and the first belt test fee.
- Dojo t-shirt (\$18) although not required, most students enjoy having the t-shirt.
- Full Gi is required for every class. No street clothes.

Tuition: \$400 full year

\$200 per student for the 1st semester due on or before the first day of class September 3, 2025

\$200 per student for the 2nd semester due on or before the first day of class January 14, 2026

LAMP students owe the yearly balance of what LAMP does not cover by October 1, 2025

Drop/Add Policy:

If a student needs to drop this class in the first 2 weeks tuition will be refunded less a prorated amount. If the drop occurs any time after the 2nd class the tuition is non-refundable. LAMP students are required to self-pay for any missed LAMP payments due to a student dropping after the 2nd class or not meeting LAMP requirements during the semester. It is the responsibility of all LAMP students to pay the yearly balance of what LAMP does not cover by October 1, 2025. New students may add the course at any time after registration, but must have consent of the tutor and REACH.
