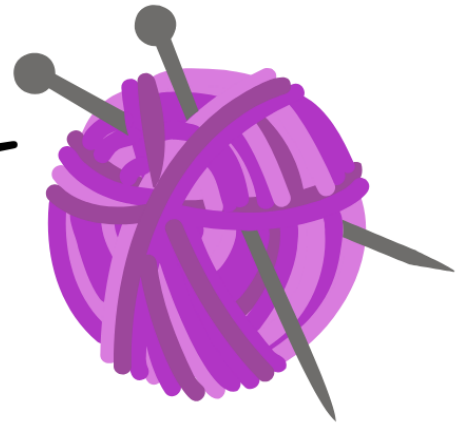


# Yarn Club

### Self Pay:

\$200 total tuition: \$100 due September 3, 2025; \$100 due January 14, 2026. If the class is dropped after the third class of the semester, tuition is not refunded.
