## ***IMPORTANT DETAILS***

**PAYMENT:** The supply fee is due August 1. Tuition payments are due in full by September 3, 2025 unless following the payment plan. Please let me know if you would like to follow the payment plan, in which case full payment is due December 17, 2025. If you would like to discuss alternative payment, you may email me at sarilwright@gmail.com. A late fee of \$10 will be applied to late payments. Cash, Check, Venmo, PayPal and LAMP are all accepted.

**LAMP:** I do accept LAMP payments for school aged children. LAMP will cover class tuition only. This means that families will be expected to pay the \$25 registration fee as well as the \$60 supply fee. If LAMP is unable to pay the full amount, or if there are missed payments, families will be expected to pay those within one month of the missed payment. LAMP payments would be \$27.77/month for 9 months.
