- Household management and budgeting expenses
- Home maintenance and organization
- Basic sewing and clothing care
- Starting and managing a small home-based business
- Time management and goal setting
- Personal health and wellness
- Safety awareness (home, online, and personal)
- Emotional intelligence and self-awareness
- Communication and conflict resolution
- Building healthy relationships and boundaries
- Helping others without becoming codependent
- Civic responsibility and community involvement
- Leadership and mentorship
- Confidence and identity in Christ
