Tuition: \$350/yr. Payable in full, LAMP, or by semester.

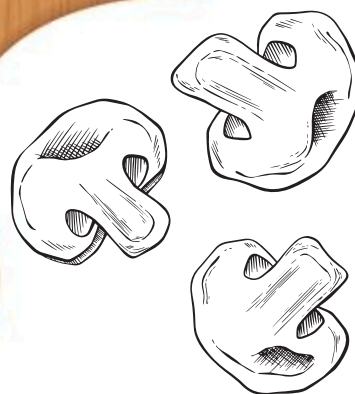
\$175 due Sept. 9th, and the remaining \$175 due Jan. 13th, 2027.
