Peter Webb teaches music in a way that gets students playing quickly. Students start learning songs and understanding how music fits together from the beginning. Beginners and advanced students accepted.

At the co-op this year, Peter is offering piano, guitar, bass, and voice. Lessons focus on things like chord charts, lead sheets, improvising, and music theory... skills that help students sit down and play with other people, not just noodle around on their own.

These aren't classical-style lessons. The focus is on chords, rhythm, and learning how songs are built. Most of the material comes from songs commonly sung in churches, making it easy for students who want to be involved in worship music to use their gifts in that environment.

Peter has been teaching in the Kalamazoo area since 2009 and has worked with well over two thousand students. He regularly works with students from different churches through lessons, classes, and camps.

Parents have seen huge success with students quickly starting to serve others with their talents with the skills they acquire from lessons with Peter.

Course Materials & Fees: Students need a three ring binder. Other supplies such as a metronome, tuner, or capo may be required.

Each lesson is \$35, paid weekly, or in a lump sum at the beginning of the year.

Students paying with LAMP funds must agree to the WorshipArts LAMP policy.

Lessons are also taught at 5701 Mt Olivet. on Mon, Tues, Thurs, should those days work better.
