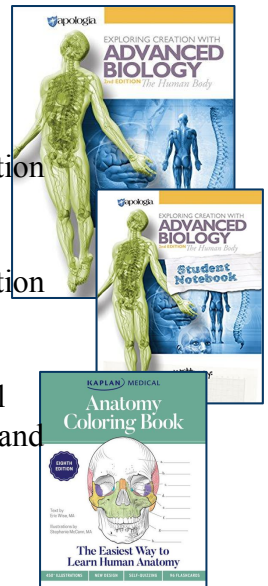
Supply Fee: \$50, non-refundable, due at registration *
