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Course Overview

This class is for young learners who have little or no Spanish speaking experience. Each week students will be introduced to Spanish in a relaxed and fun environment. A typical 40 minute class will include a combination of comprehensive input, TPR (Total Physical Response), and incidental learning methods to connect first hand experiences to Spanish vocabulary, present tense verbs, and basic sentence syntax. Students will take part in classroom routines, songs, games, art, books, videos, food, daily activities, and be introduced to holidays in the Spanish Speaking world.



Tuition and Fees

Self-Pay Fees:

Tuition: \$200 Due September 7, 2022

Supply Fee: \$40 non-refundable due at Registration*

If the class is dropped after the 2nd class of the semester, tuition is not refunded.

LAMP Fees:

Tuition: \$200 amount to be submitted to LAMP (\$22.22/mo)
