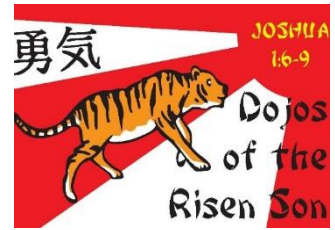

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Ages 8 – adult (6 & 7yr olds with parent as a registered student. Please call with questions)

All students begin at white belt level. Progress depends on individual maturity, ability, age and perseverance. All parents are also welcome to register. Registration includes the opportunity to attend one additional class weekly at our nearby dojo. Our program was modified this year from Taekwondo to Karate in order to provide a martial arts program for students to achieve any level of proficiency they desire. The system being taught is Tatsu Te Ryu Karate-Do and is based in Shotokan Karate. Most assignments are completed during class. Homework may include practice of forms (highly recommended) and scripture memorization.

Near the end of the semester, a belt test will be given to students who have pretested & shown readiness. Students who pass will receive an accredited belt rank at the end of the semester. If requested, a Physical Education grade will be given at the completion of this course.

Parents are encouraged to take the class with their children.

Required Materials:

- Uniform (Gi) purchased from the instructor for \$45.00 plus tax.
- The uniform fee includes Gi, the first belt test fee, dojo patch & mouth guard.
- Dojo t-shirt (\$16) although is not required but most students enjoy having the t-shirt.
- Full Gi is required for every class. No street clothes.

Tuition: \$370 full year

- \$185 per student for the first semester due the first day of class September 8, 2021 includes the \$25 non-refundable deposit due at registration
- \$160 for the 2nd semester due the first day of class January 19, 2022
- LAMP students owe the yearly balance of what LAMP does not cover by Wed October 21, 2021

Drop/Add Policy:
