Students will explore the animal world through hands-on activities, reading, and LEGO building. Children will look at specific animal habitats, where those are in the world, and the types of animals that live there. Through a feast of hands-on activities, the students will learn how these animals live, their physical features, and the incredible design that God has given each animal and habitat. Each week will include a time to build something we have learned about out of LEGO. Whether using the LEGO to build words, animal homes, or the animals themselves, the children will be able to expand on what they have learned through building and playing.

IMPORTANT DETAILS

- **Materials:** Children are asked to bring a bin of LEGO of different sizes, colors, and varieties to class each week. I will provide specific LEGO pieces as needed, as well as all other materials for the class. These materials are included in the tuition price.
- **PAYMENT:** Payments are due in full by September 8, 2021 unless following the payment plan. Please let me know if you would like to follow the payment plan, in which case full payment is due January 19, 2022. - **LAMP:** I do accept LAMP payments. LAMP will cover class tuition only. This means that families will be expected to pay the \$25 registration fee. If LAMP is unable to pay the full amount, or if there are missed payments, families will be expected to pay those within one month of the missed payment. LAMP payments would be \$31.11/ month for 9 months.
